LISTENING GUIDE

Time	Form	Lyric Cue	Listen For
0:00	Intro (14)		 Bass and drums set up the song's groove. Percussive vocalization echoes across stereo field. Synthesizer enters with repeating, 4-chord pattern.
0:28	Verse 1 (12)	"She was more like"	Lead vocal enters with heavy reverb. Jackson's voice overdubbed an octave higher at the ends of phrases.
0:53	Verse 2 (12)	"She told me her name"	As before.
1:10	Pre-chorus (8)	"People always told me"	 Contrasting musical material, as arrangement builds through the addition of new synth trumpet melody, electric piano, and splash cymbal.
1:26	Chorus (12)	"Billie Jean is not my lover"	 Verse's music returns, but with text's chorus (= simple verse-chorus). Harmony vocals enters with synth strings. Vocal octaves and rhythmic octaves in guitars at ends of phrases. Melodic "spaces" filled with stereophonic vocalizations.
1:50	Verse 3 (12)	"For forty days"	 As before, with added string melody in the synthesizer part and more activity between voice parts.
2:15	Verse 4 (12)	"She told my baby"	As verse 3.
2:32	Pre-chorus (8)	"People always told me"	Builds as before, but now with new synth string melody.
2:48	Chorus (12)	"Billie Jean is not my lover"	As before, but now with new, descending synth string melody at end of phrase.
3:05	Chorus (12)	"Billie Jean is not my lover"	Funk guitar line and synth trumpet line are added.
3:28	Interlude (12)		Rhythmic guitar line highlighted, with vocals at end.
3:54	Chorus (12)	"Billie Jean is not my lover"	As before, but with guitar line mixed forward and more vocal interjections.
4:18	Coda (16)		 Various improvised singing along with harmony vocals as song fades out.
